

ADVISORY ON THE HEALTH TECHNOLOGY ASSESSMENT (HTA) PHILIPPINES' STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT FOLLOWING THE TRANSFER OF THE HTA IMPLEMENTATION FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (DOH) TO THE DEPARTMENT OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (DOST)

On 06 March 2023, the DOH Officer-In-Charge Dr. Maria Rosario Singh-Vergeire and the DOST Secretary Dr. Renato U. Solidum., Jr. led the ceremonial turnover of the HTA Philippines from the DOH to the DOST held at the Philippine International Convention Center (PICC), Manila. This is on track with the stipulations of the Universal Health Care Law to transfer the HTA Council as an independent agency attached to the DOST within 5 years of its establishment at the DOH in 2019. As we are still in the process of completing administrative matters, please be advised that the HTA Philippines shall maintain its status quo on stakeholder engagement-related concerns until further notice.
