SUBJECT: Health Technology Assessment Council's (HTAC) Recommendations on COVID-19 health technologies


By virtue of Republic Act 11223, otherwise known as the Universal Health Care (UHC) Act, health technology assessment (HTA) shall be institutionalized as a fair and transparent priority-setting mechanism to provide financing and coverage recommendations on health technologies to be funded by the Department of Health (DOH) and the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth). Considering the public health emergency, the HTA Council (HTAC) aims to generate evidence-informed health technology recommendations amidst rapidly evolving evidence. As such, please be informed that the Secretary of Health has approved the final HTAC recommendations on the following COVID-19 health technologies:

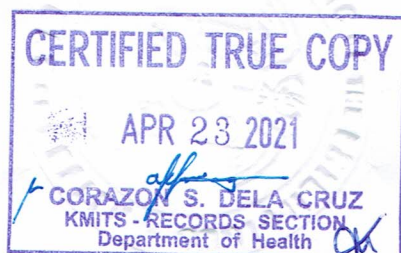
1. Sputnik V Gam-COVID-Vac COVID-19 Vaccine for the prevention of COVID-19
2. SARS-CoV-2 Vaccine (Vero Cell), Inactivated [CoronaVac] for the prevention of COVID-19
