SUBJECT: Non-acceptance of requests for exemption from the Philippine National

Formulary

In light of the recently signed Republic Act No. 11223 otherwise known as the Universal Health Care (UHC) Act, requests for exemption from Executive Order No. 49 s. 1993 (Directing the mandatory use of the Philippine National Drug Formulary (PNDF) Volume I as the Basis for Procurement of Drug Products by the Government) shall no longer be accepted and processed. As stated in the law, investments on any health technology or development of any benefit package by the DOH and PhilHealth shall be based on the positive recommendations of the Health Technology Assessment (HTA), therefore all health interventions must undergo the said process. Further, in view of the establishment of the HTA Council, the process and methods guides are currently being developed, and part of which is setting up an expedited process for the assessment of health interventions that will be used for public health emergencies.
