SUBJECT: Inclusion of Dapagliflozin 10 mg Film-coated Tablet in the Philippine

National Formulary

By virtue of Republic Act 11223, otherwise known as the Universal Health Care (UHC) Act, Health Technology Assessment (HTA) shall be institutionalized as a fair and transparent priority-setting mechanism to provide financing and coverage recommendations on health technologies to be funded by the Department of Health (DOH) and the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth).

On 31 March 2023, the Secretary of Health approved the HTA Council's recommendation for the government financing of Dapagliflozin 10 mg single-dose film-coated tablet as an add-on treatment to metformin (MET) for adults with Type 2 Diabetes Mellitus (T2DM) who have or are at a high risk of having cardiovascular disease and/or diabetic nephropathy through its inclusion in the PNF. The public is encouraged to refer to the Electronic PNF (ePNF), accessible at https://pnf.doh.gov.ph, to view the newly-included drug. Kindly disseminate this to all concerned officials in your areas of responsibility so that they may be appropriately guided in the procurement and reimbursement of drugs. All are enjoined to ensure rational procurement, distribution, and use of drugs in all government and private facilities.
